## **Quell Fire Stop**

Quell Fire Stop is a spray can with trigger mechanism, containing a fire suppressant for use against Class A, B, E, and F fire categories.

Dates sold: 7 December 2021 - 29 May 2024



Why the product is recalled: The labelling on the product does not comply with the <u>mandatory standard for portable aerosol fire</u> <u>extinguishers</u>. The product may be mistaken for a fire extinguisher when it is a fire suppressant.

**Hazard:** There is a risk of serious burns and property damage if consumers attempt to use the product beyond its capabilities as a fire extinguisher.



Consumers should stop using the product immediately.

Consumers should return the product to the place of purchase for a full refund.
